RESOLUTION NO. 94-78 - RESOLUTION OF INTENT TO STUDY THE CREATION OF A REGIONAL WATER AND SEWER AUTHORITY

Mayor Martin read the resolution and explained that it is the intent of Buncombe and Henderson counties, the cities of Asheville and Hendersonville, the Asheville-Buncombe Water Authority and the Metropolitan Sewerage District to adopt A resolution to study the creation of a regional water and sewer authority to serve the citizens within the communities represented. He said the staff of each governmental entity is directed to study and draft an agreement to create a regional water and sewer authority for recommendation to the governmental entities.

Councilwoman Sitnick moved for the adoption of Resolution No. 94-78. This motion was seconded by Councilman Watts and carried unanimously.
